## Guidelines for Submission Papers (Extended Abstracts)

- Important dates:
  - Submit your paper (extended abstract) by **December 17, 2017**.
  - A confirmation e-mail, for each paper submission, will be sent to the designated presenter.
  - A message accepting or rejecting papers (extended abstracts) will be sent by **January 19, 2018**.
  - In order to include the paper (extended abstract) in the program and in the proceedings, designated presenting authors (oral and poster presentations) **MUST** be registered for the Congress event and paid the fee by **February 2, 2018**.
  - The day and time of presentation will be communicated to the corresponding author by **April 30, 2018** and published at the Web site of the event (<https://www.worldpotatocongress2018-alap.org/en/home/>).
- Papers (extended abstracts) must be submitted in English.
- Technical Session (TS) must be indicated in the paper submission format:
  - TS1: Climate change and potato agri-food systems
  - TS2: Trends in potato consumption and market
  - TS3: Potato variety development & biotechnology
  - TS4: Potato pest and diseases
  - TS5: Potato crop management
  - TS6: Post harvest and processing technology
  - TS7: Potato biodiversity and its relation to breeding, nutrition and health
- Modality for presentation must be indicated as an oral or poster presentation.
- Include the following parts in the paper:
  - Title: A concise and informative title, should not be longer than 25 words.
  - Author(s): First name, initial for second name, and last name (e.g., María E. García). Underline the author's name who will present the paper.
  - Affiliation(s): Indicate authors' affiliation address.

- Corresponding author: Indicate the name and the e-mail address of the corresponding author.
- Abstract: Between 200 and 250 words. Avoid the use of abbreviations or acronyms.
- Keywords: Provide 3 to 5 relevant keywords for indexing purposes. Keywords must be selected from AGROVOC: <http://artemide.art.uniroma2.it:8081/agrovoc/agrovoc/en/>. Keywords should complement and differ from those of the title.
- Content: Up to 3 pages, using the formatting instructions below. Include the following sections: introduction, material and methods, results and discussion, acknowledgments, and references. One table or figure can be included (see format below).
- Format:
  - Page size: A4.
  - Page margins: 2 cm.
  - Line spacing: 1 line.
  - Font: Arial 11 pt.
  - References: Use the CSE citation system (from University of Wisconsin – Madison): [https://writing.wisc.edu/Handbook/DocCSE\\_NameYear.html](https://writing.wisc.edu/Handbook/DocCSE_NameYear.html)
  - Tables: Insert the table in the document as editable text and not as image. Place the caption at the top of the table and notes at the bottom. Use Arial 10 pt., and 1-line spacing for the text within the table.
  - Images: Insert the image in the document, with the caption at the bottom. Also, submit the image as a separate file (see below).
- Submission:
  - Papers (extended abstracts) must be submitted in Word.
  - Save the paper with the following name: technical session (TS), your last name and the initial of your full name (e.g., María Elena García: TS3\_Garcia\_MEG\_1.doc, TS3\_Garcia\_MEG\_2.doc). If you are submitting several abstracts for the same technical session, use consecutive numbers after the initials of your name.
  - If you are including an image in the paper, save the image in TIFF or JPEG format, with a resolution of at least 1200 dpi, as a separate document. Use the same name as the Word document.
